

Contribution to fight Covid 19

Asmara, 11 July 2020

Public contribution to augment National Fund to combat the spread of corona virus is continuing.

According to the daily report from the Ministry of Health, cooperative association of former members of the office of secretariat contributed 50 thousand Nakfa, and several cooperative associations, administrative areas as well as small scale businesses contributed a total of over 37 thousand Nakfa.

Likewise, Eritreans and friends of Eritrea in Athens, Greek, contributed 3 thousand and 260 Euro to augment the National Fund to combat the spread of corona virus.

In related news, Mr. Osman Ahmedin, head of youth organization in Foro sub-zone, commended the role of the youth in the sub zone in the effort to develop the awareness and contribution of the public in the fight to combat the spread of corona virus.

Mr. Osman went on to say that the youth apart from respecting the guidelines to combat the spread of COVID-19 pandemic are involved in encouraging the public to follow the guidelines being issued by the Government to contain the spread of the corona virus pandemic.

Nationals in the Scandinavian countries contributed over 260 thousand Kroner to augment the National Fund to contain the spread of corona virus and Martyrs Trust Fund.

According to the Eritrean Embassy in the Scandinavian countries, 'Eri Tsinat' Pal Talk Forum contributed 81 thousand Kroner in the name of the late Awelker Seid, former editor and coordinator of the forum, the National Holidays Coordinating Committee in the Scandinavian countries 50 thousand and 100 Kroner in the name of the late Berhane Tilahun, former cahier of the committee, residents of Ockelbo 6 thousand Kroner, national committee in Denmark 7 thousand Kroner and one national contributed 6 thousand Kroner.

Similarly, Eritrean nationals in Sweden contributed 41 thousand Kroner, nationals in Oslo and its environs 30 thousand Kroner, nationals in Trondheim, Norway, 30 thousand Kroner, nationals in Ulsteinvik, Norway, 7 thousand and 257 Kroner.

A number of nationals in the Scandinavian countries also decided that the families renting their houses in various parts of the country to live free of rental payment ranging from three months until the end of 2020.

In related news, 14 owners of small businesses in Edaga area, Massawa, contributed 8 thousand and 600 Nakfa, 22 thousand and 500 Nakfa.

Communities and owners of businesses extended financial contribution to the effort to combat COVID-19 pandemic.

Accordingly, Cathedral kindergarten contributed 8 thousand and 167 Nakfa, Yordanos shop 5 thousand and other small businesses, cooperative associations and individuals contributed a total of 41 thousand Nakfa.

In related news, residents of the sub-zones of Adi-Keih and Dubarwa, Southern region, extended financial and food items to disadvantaged citizens in their areas.

Likewise, residents of the administrative areas of Mendefera and Hawatsu, Adi-Keih sub-zone, distributed food items to disadvantaged citizens and 8 thousand Nakfa to families of martyrs while residents of the administrative areas of Maelewia and Tegeren distributed food items to disadvantaged citizens and 5,600 Nakfa to families of martyrs.

Similarly, residents of the administrative areas of Adi-Gebrai, Adi-Seldait, Takita and Shiketi, Dubarwa sub-zone extended food items and 40 thousand Nakfa to disadvantaged families.

A number of nationals in the sub-zones also decided that the families renting their houses to live free of rental payment ranging from one to two months.
