## I. Introduction and executive summary

### 1. Introduction

**'Eritrea: Essential Education Indicators** is the official, annual education publication of the Ministry of Education (MoE) dealing with basic essential indicators. It is the 26<sup>th</sup> report produced by the Department of Research and Human Resource Development in terms of organization of schools in the six administrative Zobas. The sources of information for this publication are annual school censuses carried out by Zoba education offices through standard questionnaires.

This publication covers data from Early Childhood Education (ECE) up to General Education (Elementary, Middle and Secondary level). The main purpose of the 2023/24 publication is to provide useful, relevant, reliable and up-to-date information on education for various stakeholders within and outside the education sector.

The MoE believes that the data presented in this publication is by no means exhaustive. For further inclusion and refinement to be made, the Ministry of Education is working to improve the quality and coverage of the education statistics. Moreover, continuous efforts will be made to produce better and timely information.

This publication would not have been possible without the contribution of the six Zoba Education offices and other educational institutions. The Department remains deeply indebted to all for the efforts made to successfully finalize this publication.

The MoE truly appreciates to all those who provided feedback and other relevant input.

## **2. Executive summary**

In the academic year 2023/24 enrolment in elementary, middle and secondary levels increased by 5.5%, 3.4% and 14.1% respectively as compared to 2022/23. The increase in enrolment in elementary and secondary level was observed in all Zobas, with an increase of 11.8% in Semenawi keih bahri and 36.5% increase in sawa respectively. The increase in enrolment in middle level was also observed in all Zobas except in Maekel with a decrease of 3.2% as compared to the previous academic year.

In the academic year 2023/24, enrolment of girls in elementary, middle and secondary levels increased by 5.8%, 4.1 and 13.9 % respectively.

In the academic year 2023/24 national enrolment of girls and boys increased by 6.5% and 5.7 % respectively as compared to the academic year 2022/23. The gross enrolment ratios of females in pre-primary, elementary, middle and secondary levels were 24.6, 117.2, 96.9 and 33.3 % respectively.

In pre-primary education, the number of students has increased by 8 percent and the number of teachers has increased also by 7.5 %. The number of schools in pre-primary has increased also by 9.6 %. The number of schools by level in elementary , middle and secondary increased by 1.7%, 4.9 % and 10.9% respectively, there was significant increment in the number of secondary schools as compared to the previous academic years. The number of teachers has increased in elementary, middle and secondary levels by 3.6%, 16.2% and 9.8% respectively.

The gross national accessibility to schooling in 2023/24 was about 25 %, 117 %, 95 % and 33 % in pre-primary, elementary, middle and secondary levels respectively.

The subsequent sections of this publication/abstract show the overall situation of the education system at all levels as well as some statistical information obtained since 2000/01 academic year.

### 3. Data channels

The information in this statistical abstract is gathered mainly from three questionnaires named number 7, 8 and 9. The first two questionnaires consist of closed questions/items, in which schools and institutions send back the *November data* on Pre-primary, Elementary, Middle, and Secondary schools to the MoE. The expected time of completion of these questionnaires is April. In every academic year 100% of the questionnaires are collected.

Items in questionnaire 9 cover school physical, financial and internal efficiency particulars. The expected time of completion of this Questionnaire is July, which is after the end of each academic year.

The Department assures users of this abstract that all necessary measures have been taken to make the information provided in this issue valid and reliable.

Data in all tables, unless otherwise stated, refer to the academic year 2023/24. Table numbers are sub-grouped under corresponding sections. Charts are sequenced in a continuous ascending order throughout the abstract.

## II. Important notes

- We would like to remind users of our yearly abstracts that we have been using different school age estimations in our previous publications. From 2012 onwards our publications has been based on the new school age estimation made by the National Statistics Office (NSO).

### 2. Definitions

- 2.1 Government schools** are schools administered and financed by the Ministry of Education.
- 2.2 Non-government schools** are schools administered and financed by institutions other than the Ministry of Education.

**2.3 Special schools** are schools for those with hearing and visual impairment. There are two schools for those with hearing impairment in Keren and Asmara and one school for those with visual impairment in Asmara.

**2.4 Number of schools by level:**

A school having grades 1-12 is considered as three (1-5, 6-8, 9-12) schools by **level** regardless of being single **site**; schools having grades 1-8 are considered as two schools as it contains two levels (1-5 and 6-8) and the same for schools having grades 6-12.

**2.5 Number of schools by site:**

One single school compound or **site** may accommodate a combination of two or three level of schools but may be counted as one school **for purposes of specific location**. The number of schools by level is usually greater than the number of schools by site.

Tables 1 and 2 give the number of students and teachers of General Education, Asmara Community College of Education (ACCE) and Technical and vocational schools (TVET) since 2000/01.

## IV. Pre-primary level

### 1. Pre-primary schools

In the academic year 2023/24, there were 777 pre-primary schools in the whole country, out of which 367(47.2%) are located in Zoba Maekel and Debub. In 2023/24 out of the total schools, 76% of them are located in rural areas of the country.

In the academic year 2023/24, 610 (78.5%) and 167 (21.5%) schools are owned by government and non government respectively.



### 3. Pre-primary teachers

During the academic year 2023/24, there were 2,125 pre-primary teachers in the whole country of whom 723 (34%) have professional training.

As table 9 indicates 2,039 or 96% of teachers in pre-primary schools were female. Whereas male teachers were only 4%.

## V. Elementary level

### 1. Background


The official school age for elementary level is 6-10 and the duration of stay is 5 years. Education in government schools is free and compulsory. At elementary level the medium of instruction is mother tongue.

### 2. Enrolment

Enrolment at elementary level in the academic year 2023/24 was 440,155 out of which 201,553 (45.7%) were females. As can be seen from the table below, there was an increment in enrolment by 5.5% as compared to the previous year.

### 1. Background


The duration of Middle level is three years (Grades 6, 7 and 8). It is the second level of the compulsory basic education. English is the language of instruction in this level. The official School age is 11-13.

### 2. Enrolment

Enrolment in this level for the academic year 2023/24 was 196,795. Female enrolment was 87,518 (44.5%) of the total number. As can be seen from the table below, there was an increment in enrolment by 3.4% as compared to the previous year.



### 1. Background


The duration of Secondary level is four years (Grades 9-12). The official school age is 14-17. Education is also free at this level. The medium of instruction is English.





## VIII. Internal efficiency

### 1. Length of school year.

The duration of the school year in the academic year 2023/24 was 180 days in the highlands and 191 days in the lowlands. The number of periods per week in grades 1, 2, and 3 were 30 and in grades 4 and 5 were 35.

In the academic year 2023/24, schooling in the lowlands began on September 05 and ended on May 31. In the highlands it began on September 05 and ended on June 30. Schools in the lowlands, teach 6 days a week while schools in the highlands, teach 5 days a week.





**Figure 1: Elementary level: hypothetical cohort reconstruction (Constant) ERITREA**
